

Analisa Bienvenida Teachworth

(b. 1985, Detroit)

Lives and works in New York City

Analisa Teachworth is a Latino, American artist working in a wide range of mediums spanning the digital and physical spectrum. Her practice creatively melds artistic expertise with technological prowess, used to reimagine digital spaces, reinforce social awareness, and reshape public discourse.

Teachworth's work has been exhibited at MoMA PS1, Hamburger Bahnhof-Museum of the Present, Berlin, Kunst-Werke Institute for Contemporary Art, Berlin and The New Museum. She is the Founder and Creative Director of 4REAL, a digital agency and artist collective based in New York City. And additionally a Co-Founder of the online platform Relevant - a decentralized application for the sharing and curation of news.

Her practice encompasses the production of new media art bridging the realm between physical space and digital tools to establish a merging of social commentary, cultural symbolism, and individual creativity. Her multidisciplinary background distinctively mixes classic artistic traditions - performance, sculpture, installation with contemporary technologies - video, sound, and web development.

Within her performative discipline, the audience is often drawn into participation whereas the creation of websites and online platforms becomes space for her and other's self-representational purposes. The use of the physical self is an inherent metaphor within her body of work, portraying an active role in reference to a history of femininity and an inevitable discourse of post-colonial society. Here she explores tropes of liminality, her Hispanic ancestry, displacement, and upbringing in the landscape of an abandoned industrial Detroit.

The incorporation of digital strategies within her work acts as a subversive and significant reflection of society in general. Raising agency over the ethics and use of contemporary tools being a reality machine, defining most of our economies not just within our inner selves but also in what lies beyond us. Her methods of storytelling envision communication on a technological level and project it into the realms of artistic tradition. Within her intuitive agenda, she seeks to reclaim and reconstruct not only her experiences but history itself.
