

Analisa Teachworth 1987 Detroit, Michigan

Based between New York City, USA, and Berlin, Germany, Analisa Teachworth is a multidisciplinary artist whose practice includes painting, sculpture, digital media, and installation. Teachworth's distinct and artistic world-building is diverse and versatile in medium, correlating personal experience to allegorical histories and unknown futures to construct an intimate, unique material lexicon. Through her investigation of materiality and form, her artworks examine relationships between spatiality, place, and experience. Teachworth's interchanging of materialistic tools acts as a metaphor to remodel our relationship to what is natural vs. artificial, real, and imagined, highlighting agency and ethics.

Her practice cumulates works that explore collective awareness, contextualizing personal motifs while vivifying the void's emptiness. The artist's upbringing in an abandoned landscape of post-industrial Detroit, USA, and her Puerto Rican, Caribbean, ancestry blend divergent influence. Her storytelling correlates ideological and technological systems that function as reality machines, defining intellectual, emotional, and physical economies that extend beyond the inner outward into the social fabric. Her works materialize with deliberation to highlight and free notions of the history of femininity and engage with post-colonial discourse through expressionist forms of otherness. Teachworth envisions alternate trajectories of communication through making that seek to reclaim and reconstruct her own experiences and the narrative of collective history.
